We're working in partnership with Scottish Government to provide this package in line with their commitment to young carers



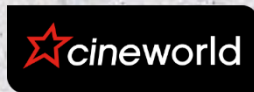

Notes:

* Application – the online form is as light as possible, including only a handful of questions to help us ensure that the opportunities are going to young carers.

**Verification – The application form will request the contact details of a trusted adult. Depending on the information provided applications will either be automatically verified or Young Scot staff will approve the application manually. Our default position will be to trust the young person
